June 29, 1998: WWE Champion for a day on *Raw*—and loving every second of it! Paul is a bit concerned about my rematch with Stone Cold Steve Austin.



Circa July/August 1998: Posing with Mankind, the first of my seven Tag Team Championship partners.



March 28, 1999: Pete Rose just wouldn't learn his lesson!



August 23, 1999: X-Pac is pumped on *Raw* for Kane's signature pyro, and my newfound ability to speak!



June 23, 2003: Unmasked for the first time in six years, as a fresh reign of terror begins on *Raw*.
